

Veeva CRM Maintenance Release Notes – 191.13.0

Account Management

Online: Dependent fields controlled by a check box were not populated based on the default value on a DCR screen. This has been fixed. (CRM-175772)

Call Reporting

Windows: When a user on a call displayed media with a very long thumbnail name and then selected an account, the Call screen displayed but was unresponsive. This has been fixed. (CRM-175538)

iPad: When a user selected an account while viewing media, additional temporary calls were created on the mobile device but were never synced. This occurred only when the Select Call Record Type setting was disabled and the Enable Child Account setting was enabled. This has been fixed. (CRM-175725)

CLM

Windows: After navigating to a slide in a hidden presentation, the Back button was unresponsive. This has been fixed. (CRM-176625)

Consent Capture

iPad: Selecting Done after adding an email address on the Manage Email Addresses popup caused an error. This has been fixed. (CRM-176868)

Engage Meeting

Windows: Slides did not display in the correct order for certain OS language settings. This has been fixed. (CRM-176843)

Engage for Portals

MC: The Engage Metadata Sync Administration Console was unresponsive when a user selected Sync. This has been fixed. (CRM-176505)

Engage Webinar

Windows: When a slide was updated, speakers in the Engage Application were not prompted to redownload the content, and the last-modified date on the presentation header was unchanged. This has been fixed. (CRM-176334)

Events Management

iPad: When a user attempted to add a combination of inside- and outside-territory attendees to an event and one attendee did not pass a validation rule, an error occurred during sync. This has been fixed. (CRM-175726)

Online: The External_ID_vod field was missing from the Child_Event_Rule_Config_vod object. This has been fixed. (CRM-175804)

Network Integration

Online: An error occurred during scheduled outbound Network integration process jobs. This has been fixed. (CRM-176446)
